



Corneil contacted Access to Independence seeking help with employment in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic.



Soon after he had started working towards his career goals, Corneil was able to land a job! Through the advocacy and services that Corneil received, he now has stable housing, stable income, and opportunities for additional training and education.


About Artists Beyond Boundaries

Artists Beyond Boundaries is an unique art event and fundraiser that celebrates the artwork of artists with disabilities.

This event is an extension of Access to Independence's mission. Just as the agency empowers people to live as independently as they choose, Artists Beyond Boundaries empowers artists with disabilities to share their works of art with a wider audience, and have an opportunity to be recognized for their work.

Artists Beyond Boundaries is an event created to demonstrate the power of art, and the contributions of artists with disabilities in our communities, and beyond.





How it works



Step 1 Call for Art

Artists with disabilities of any age, and of any skill level, are invited to submit up to two works of art to the event.



Step 2 Jurors

We work with a panel of jurors made up of professional artists and others from the visual art community to help us determine the top twelve works of art.



Step 3 Virtual Event Premier

On October 6th, 2022, we'll host a live-stream event showcasing ALL artwork submitted to the event and announce the year's "Top Twelve" works of art. These winning works will be featured in the next Artists Beyond Boundaries calendar, and each finalist will receive a cash award.



Step 4 People's Choice Award

All live stream viewers will get to vote on the thirteenth and final winner by voting for the "People's Choice Award." The People's Choice Award winner will have their artwork featured on the cover of the calendar, and the winning artist will also receive a cash award.
